How can I view and track receipt of my financial aid requirements?

You can do ALL of this online by following these instructions:

- Navigate to the Financial Aid Checklist found on the Application Status page https://connect.lafayette.edu/apply/status
- Enter your *Email Address* that you have previously provided to Admissions along with the *Password* that you created*
- The Status of each of the Details (requirements) will appear on this page along with any links/messages related to individual requirements.

*In the event that you have not yet created your password to log into the Application Status page, please locate the email message that was sent to you acknowledging the receipt of your Admissions application. It contains the details required to access your account and create your password.

If you cannot recall your password, click on *Forgot Your Password?* found on the Login page. This will allow you to regain access to your account. Further assistance is also available by contacting Admissions via Admissions@lafayette.edu.

What if I am ONLY seeking a Marquis Fellowship/Scholarship or ONLY applying for loan assistance?

- If you are only seeking academic merit funding from the Marquis programs, you do not need to apply for financial aid. No further documents are required. Eligibility is determined by the Admissions staff during the review your Admissions application.
- The FAFSA is the single required application if you are only seeking federal loans.

Please send an email to financialaid@lafayette.edu, indicating which type of aid (scholarship only or loan only) you are applying for, your full name and the ID found at the bottom of our reminder communication. Once we receive this correspondence, we will not send you any reminders for additional requirements.

Can my financial aid application affect the admission decision?

As a matter of practice, Lafayette may withhold your admission decision if you have indicated on your admission application that you are applying for financial aid, but have not submitted the necessary financial aid requirements to complete your financial aid application.
